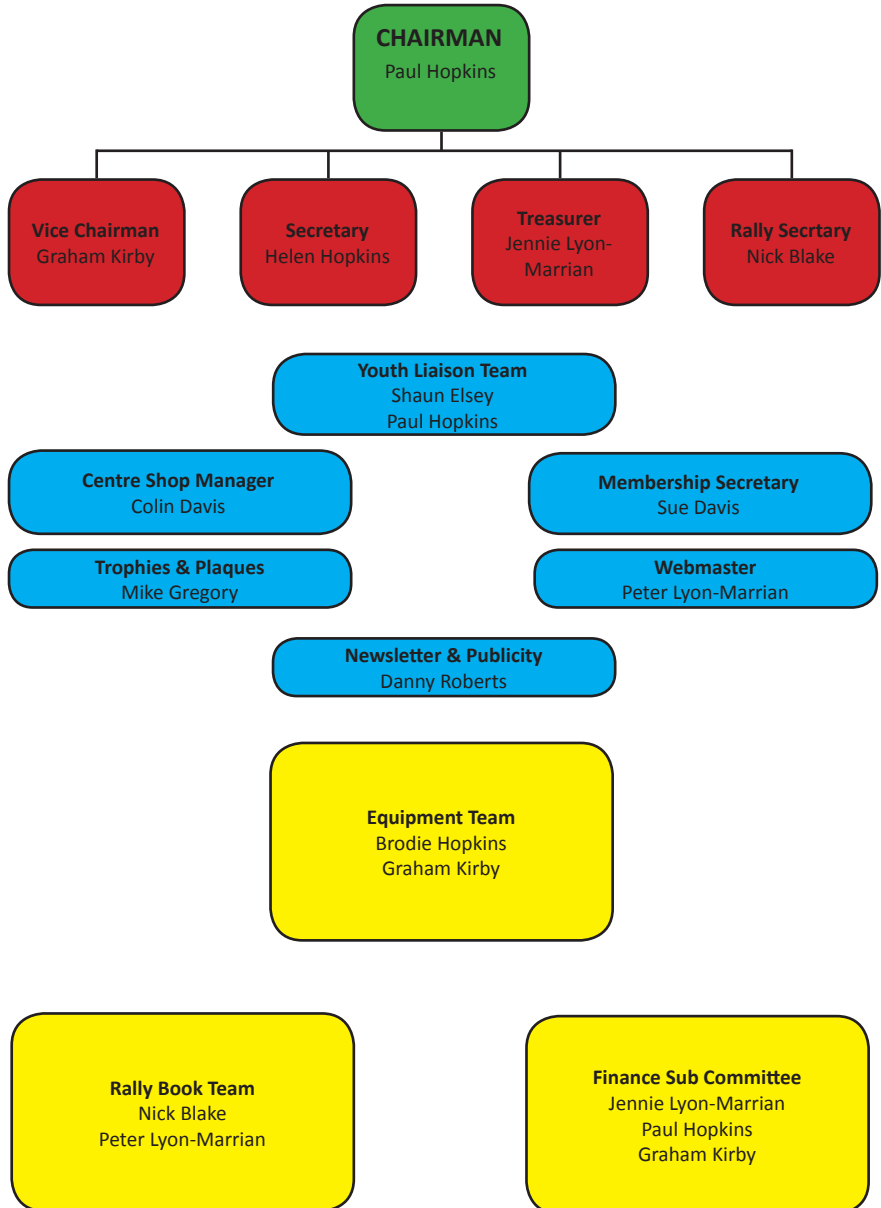

Treasurer's Note

Regarding the collection of funds – it is the Caravan Club ruling that all money, cheques or cash collected by the rally officer or other persons on behalf of the centre, must be banked in the centre bank account only, and the credit slip sent to me as soon as possible. Please, at the very least, notify me of your deposit, the deposit slip number and the rally that it is for.

All monies collected by the rally officers should be paid into the bank, except if the landowner can be paid in cash. Any refunds must be made by me, on the instruction of the committee. If a rally officer feels that a refund should be made for compassionate reasons, they must make a recommendation to the Committee.

West Hampshire Centre AGM 2018

The fifty Third Annual General Meeting of the West Hampshire Centre of the Caravan Club will be held at Copythorne Parish Hall, Copythorne on Sunday 7th October 2018 at 1.30pm.

As required by Rule 6(c) Rules Governing Centres, nominations for Executive Office or Committee signed by the nominee must be received in writing by the Centre Honorary Secretary not later than 14 days prior to the Meeting (23th September 2017, by 1.30pm).

Only members who submitted their Centre Registration Card at least 35 days prior to the date of the meeting and are still registered Centre Member at the date of the AGM are entitled to speak or vote, although the Club Constitution does not forbid the admission of spouses or other persons of the Member's family.

MEMBERS AND FAMILY MEMBERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARD BEFORE RECEIVING THEIR VOTING PAPER AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL MEMBERS AND FAMILY MEMBERS TO ENSURE THAT THEY ARE IN POSSESSION OF BALLOT PAPERS PRIOR TO A BALLOT TAKING PLACE.

Rallying Hints and Tips

Booking in for Rallies

The majority of rallies can now be booked online via <https://www.whampshirecc.co.uk>. Alternatively you can complete one of the rally slips from the centre of this book and send it to the named Rally Officer for the rally concerned at least **17 days before the Rally**.

When booking online you will receive an acknowledgement of your booking automatically. If you send a slip then an acknowledgement of booking is not normally sent unless a rally is full or has been cancelled. If you forward a stamped addressed envelope, most rally officers will be happy to acknowledge receipt. **Extra rally booking slips can be obtained from any Officer or Committee member.** Early booking is advised for Bank Holidays and Holiday Rallies. NB. Some rallies have narrow or difficult access or are otherwise unsuitable for large or heavy outfits. If you have any doubts or concerns, please ask the Rally Officer **before** booking.

Payment for the majority of rallies except holiday and special rallies, eg Christmas Party, is made on arrival. Payment can also be made online for some rallies. Ask the rally officer if they will accept online payment or not.

Cancellation If you find at the last minute that you can't attend a rally, please do everything possible to let the Rally Officers know by the Wednesday prior to the rally. **Where expense has been incurred on your behalf for social events/catering etc. which cannot be recovered or re-allocated, you will be responsible for reimbursing the Centre**

What to do after you have booked your rally and the weekend arrives. Follow the directions in the rally book. As you approach the rally site, you will see small RED directional signs with WHCC (or CWH) lettering on them in white to help you find the entrance.

Rally Officers arrange the weekend for you and you will meet them when you arrive on site. Once you have booked in, you will be handed an envelope containing the programme for the weekend, which often includes a competition. You will then be shown to your pitch.

The Rally Officers have given up their time to run the rally and will try to assist you if you experience any difficulty before or during the rally. Please be courteous and appreciative to them at all times.

The Centre Officers and Committee delegate responsibility for the organisation and running of the rally to the appointed Rally Officers. Please remember that they are volunteers who, as a token of appreciation to other ralliers, devote one or more

weekends to running a rally for your enjoyment.

Social functions and competitions may be included during the weekend and they are all family rallies and good fun. Please note that an additional fee may be charged for such activities. Participation is optional.

Flagpole: This is where you and your fellow ralliers gather to hear results of competitions, welcome visitors and new ralliers, hear announcements of forthcoming Rallies and thank the Rally Officers.

Disposal Points: The use of wastewater filters is not permitted on any rally and waste water must not be drained directly onto the rally field from your outfit. **Disposal points for Chemical Toilets and Wastewater will be clearly marked – do not wash out chemical toilets or waste tanks at the water point.** If you have the slightest doubt, please ask the Rally Officer.

Rubbish: Members are expected to take home all rubbish and it is not usual for the Centre to provide bags for this purpose.

Arrival Times at Rallies: Members must not impose on Rally Officers by arriving prior to the advertised starting time of the rally as this can contravene local or national regulations related to use of the site. Please do not arrive before 8am or after 10pm without prior agreement with the Rally Officers.

Speed on the Rally Field: The speed of all vehicles including pedal cycles **must not exceed walking pace. Please keep to roadways and centre lines at all times.** Members who consistently fail to observe this Speed Limit will be **asked to leave** the Rally Field and action will be taken against offending members

Rally officers are empowered to restrict the movement of vehicles on the rally field during bad weather. If the ground conditions are particularly severe, vehicle movement will only be allowed at the discretion of the rally officer. However, if the yellow flag is flying, then no vehicle movement will be allowed without the express permission of the rally officer.

Saving Pitches: The saving of pitches for friends is limited to a **maximum of two.**

Noise: Musical Instruments, radios, TV etc., must not be used to the inconvenience of other people on the site. Members are asked to be considerate to others after 23.00 hours by keeping noise to a minimum. Generators must only be used at the discretion of the rally officers.

Accommodation: A pitch is large enough to accommodate one caravan, one awning and one car.

Pets: Cats, Dogs etc., **must be on a lead** and under control on the rally field. The length of the **lead should not exceed 10 feet** from any point of the caravan. Pets should also be exercised off the rally field. **Under no circumstances** should they be allowed to foul the ground in the vicinity of the caravans. Please consider insuring your pet to cover yourself for any unfortunate incidents. Pets will NOT be permitted at any social event or kitchen facilities. This is to protect animals, occupants and equipment and we trust you will respect this decision.

Visitors: All visitors must report to the Rally Office and register with the Rally Officers on arrival. Visitors are politely requested to park as directed by rally officers.

Games in Caravan Lines: Members will appreciate the damage that can be caused when a Cycle, Ball, Frisbee or Kite etc. comes into contact with a car or caravan. **These games are not permitted in caravan lines.**

Complaints: If you have a legitimate complaint, which you have been unable to resolve mutually you should report it to the Rally Officers or a member of the Centre's Committee at the time, for action if felt necessary. The Caravan Club Rules Governing Centres Article 8 authorises the Centre Committee to deal with appropriate incidents. All Centre Officers and Committee display name plaques in the front window of their caravans, and invite you to discuss any caravanning issues with them.

Please note that the Committee cannot resolve trivial complaints such as personal disagreements, differences of opinion between individual members followed by arguments etc. However, if such irritations adversely impact upon the comfort and convenience of other members, the Centre Committee will consider taking action against the individuals concerned in order that they can resolve their issues without involving other Club members.

Tents, Awnings, Windbreaks and Canopies: Rally Officers, **must be consulted** before any tent is erected. Some sites we use do not allow tents. **SMALL** tents (sufficient to sleep two people) may be allowed. **A minimum space of 15 feet** must be left between outfits to allow for **emergency access**. Where an awning annexe is used it must not extend beyond the caravan and should be erected at the A-frame end.

Fire Buckets should be filled and placed in front of each van for emergency use. These are not meant to put out fires, just to aid in getting to safety. In the event of a fire evacuate the area and call the fire brigade.

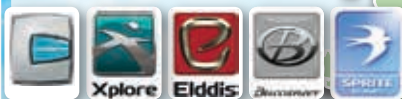
